



1ST SAMFORD VALLEY CUB SCOUT PACK

Welcome to our Cub Pack!

We meet on Wednesday evenings in the School Hall at Holbrook High School. To enable us to start at 6.30pm could all Cubs arrive by 6.25pm. For the Cubs' safety they need to be left at and picked up from the room, not allowed to walk from the car park alone.

Subs are due on the first week of term - they are currently set at £26. We ask parents to pay online as this saves our leaders time. You will be sent a link that will enable you to do this.

When out representing the Pack full uniform is to be worn unless told otherwise. Full uniform is Cub jumper, Group scarf, uniform trousers/smart school trousers/skirt and smart shoes. For weekly meetings Cub jumper and scarf, 'scruff' trousers/shorts (could girls please ensure if they wear skirts they have leggings or shorts on under them) and shoes/trainers (crocs/uggs etc are not suitable for running around in). Uniform jumpers and scarves are to be worn at every Grand Howl. All scarves, jumpers and coats should be labelled with the Cub's name.

Inspection will focus on general appearance and tidiness, e.g. clean and smart uniforms and scarves, clean hands and shoes. Cubs do not need to bring badge books, pen, pad etc. but these and any other useful 'extras' (e.g. torches) brought will earn points for their Six. Points are also awarded or deducted for behaviour, participation etc. A trophy (Micky the Mascot Monkey!) is awarded to the most helpful cub of the meeting for safe-keeping until the next week.

Cubs are encouraged to work towards badges at home as well as at meetings. Details of badges they would like to do can be obtained from a leader or at <http://www.scouts.org.uk/supportresources/search/?cat=12,67>

We are unable to provide drinks so Cubs should bring a bottle of water with them if required (particularly during the warmer months). If Cubs miss a meeting could they ask other Cubs (at school etc.) if there is anything they need to know (e.g. change of venue or time for next meeting).

Most correspondence will be via email. Please check regularly and reply promptly if required.

We will endeavour to finish for 8.00pm, but please understand if we do run over, which can occur if, for example, there are a lot of badges to be given out.

If anything happens that you think may affect your child at Cubs please don't hesitate to let us know.

And lastly.....if you would like to lend a hand at any of the weekly meetings or have a skill/hobby/talent etc you would like to share with the Cubs please let me know, it's all for their benefit!
